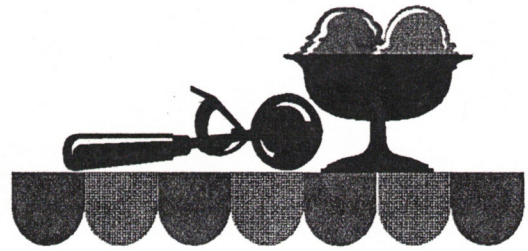


# Here's the Scoop
